Motion to clean and videotape gravity section of 8 inch pipe on Route 154

Chairman Armington noted there had been discussions about cleaning the gravity feed section of the sewer on Route 154. The cost would be approximately \$2,200. Motion by Armington, second by Ward, to approve the cleaning and videotaping of the gravity side of the sewer system on Route 154 to see if there are any other obstacles that may come down and interfere with the flow meter at a cost of approximately \$2,200. Unanimously Approved. Motion Carried. Armington noted the cleaning and videotaping is scheduled for Friday.

Chairman Armington noted he sent a letter to Deep River last month, but has not heard anything back yet.


New Business - none.
