CALL TO ORDER

Chairman Ward called the meeting to order at 7:03 p.m. In attendance included: Ed Meehan, Mark Riggio and Sam Chorches. Absent: Ian McLachian.

OLD BUSINESS

Little House Brewery Permit Update

The permit for the Little House Brewery has been signed and the establishment has opened. Ed Ward will contact Jacobson to observe the operations and collect samples for testing. Test results should be available for the September or October WPCA meeting.

Ed Meehan made a motion to add to the agenda a follow-up discussion on the equipment damaged last Fall. Mark Riggio seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

Ed Ward reported that he spoke with Lynn Murphy, Smith Brothers, USA Insurance Co., regarding a claim for damage to equipment that occurred in the Fall of 2017. Invoices have been submitted (totaling over \$10,000). The insurance company is expected to respond to Ed. All equipment is operational and the lines were cleaned in May.

Chester is now a member of the Health District and they will begin performing restaurant inspections. The Sanitarian will be invited to a future WPCA meeting.

NEW BUSINESS

9 Water Street Sewer Hookup Inquiry

Ed Ward reported that he received an e-mail from Mr. Greg Fedus, Fedus Engineering expressing an interest in a sewer hook-up for the 9 Water Street property (prior bank building). The vacant property is in the sewer service area. All costs associated with any hook-up are the responsibility of the property owner. Mr. Fedus was encouraged to contact Brian Curtis, Jacobson and Associates, for further information. WPCA members were in support of additional users on the system.

Ed Meehan reported that he will follow-up with the First Selectman's Administrative Assistant regarding WPCA regulations and the 7/10/18 meeting minutes on the Town's website.
