Citation Review Board
Minutes of Meeting of January 11, 2021

1. Call to Order

The meeting, held in the Town Hall, was called to order at 7: 11 P.M. Present were Kathy Merola, Whitey Wilson and Bettie Perreault. There was no audience of citizens.

2. Request to Review Citations: Because there was no one present to represent the request for review of Citation #026-141, the Board chose to delay the start of the meeting in case the person was simply delayed and to proceed with other business on the agenda.

a. Citation #026-141, Cynthia Erickson - Traveling Unreasonably Fast - Route 148/ Camp Hazen.

3. Guests

There were none present.

4. Review of and Decision on Citation Review Request

a. Citation #026-141, Cynthia Erickson - Traveling Unreasonably Fast - Route 148/ Camp Hazen.

It was noted for the record that Chester Police utilize a laser unit that is calibrated regularly to ensure accuracy, and that the officer who issued the Citation verified this information. It was further pointed out that the correspondence notifying the complainant of this scheduled meeting included information regarding hearing procedures for citations and other fines, including that a failure to appear penalty of not more than the original citation amount may be applied.

On Motion by Kathy Merola, seconded by Whitey Wilson, in the absence of representation in connection with Citation #026-141, the Citation remains valid and in effect, with a penalty charge of \$25 for failure to appear, and the fine, \$75 plus \$25 penalty, a total of \$100 becomes due and payable within ten (10) days of the mailing of this decision. The motion passed unanimously.

5. Approval of Minutes - October 12, 2020

No action was taken; minutes will be acted upon at the next meeting of the Citation Review Board.

6. Old Business - Board members reviewed the remedial work that had been performed to alleviate sight line and signage problems at the following locations: Parkers Point Boat Launch Area, Cedar Lake Terrace Beach and Straits Road/Maple Street. The Public Works Department had successfully addressed all.

7. New Business - there was none.
