FACE MASK MANDATE

The BOS discussed the pros and cons of continuing with the mask mandate in Town buildings. The Region 4 school system has made the wearing of masks optional.

The Town experienced 5 cases of Covid-19 last week.

Tom Englert made a motion to discontinue the mask mandate in Town buildings. The wearing of masks will now be optional. Ed Meehan seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.
