### Minutes

Called to order at 7:03PM, in attendance were:

Chairman Kane provide a brief introduction of the residential dock proposal at #27 Parkers Point Road, and asked March Jackson to provide further details.

Details include:

- 4' x 97' pier with a PWC elevator and boat lift
- Pier is 6'5" above mean high tide and has open grate decking as recommended by DEEP
- Originally plan was approved by DEEP in 2004, in 2015 they re-submitted with the PWC Lift addition. Currently DEEP is satisfied with the preliminary request.
- Commissioners are tentatively planning a site walk at mean low tide on 6/21.

Chairman Kane confirmed that dredging is completed, and almost all of the final invoices have been submitted, she is still working on the final numbers, she is anticipating the project will be under budget.

Chairman Kane will identify a date in April/May 2023 to run a Coast Guard Safety Inspection event at Camp Hazen. Camp Hazen has indicated they will support such an event. More details to come at a later date.

Chairman Kane re-introduced conversation about channel markers, it was noted that if we proceed with that we should look into markers for the mooring field as well. Commissioner Devanney will look into the DEEP permit and what is entailed. Commissioner Dean, working with Harbor Master Libby, is going to get accurate up to date copies of chart showing the areas in question.

Chairman Kane brought up the subject of additional grant money is available from the state, and asked for feedback. A motion was made by Commissioner Devanney to review and research possible upgrades/replacement for Parkers Point Boat Launch. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Barrington, and all voted in favor.

Other important note: Harbormaster and Deputy Harbormaster received their re-certifications and are in good standing until 2025.
